## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

1) All manuscripts (in e-mail) must be accompanied by:

- a) A covering letter with the name(s) of the author(s), the title of the manuscript and contact information (email, phone, etc.)
- b) An Abstract of not more than 300 words must be attached with the Paper describing the submission of the Article.

c) Word limit:

Articles - 3500 – 5000 Words

Book Review – Not more than 2000 Words

Case Analysis – Not more than 1500 Words

2) All Submissions should be made in Word Format (.doc) / (.docx)

3) All submissions are required to be typewritten in Font Times New Roman with 12 points font size, line spacing 1.5' justified.

4) Text and citations should ideally conform to the rules in the Bluebook: a uniform system of citation (19<sup>th</sup> Edition).

All submissions must be made in accordance with submission guidelines of the Editorial Board. The Detailed guidelines are available on the website of Student Law Review.
